Don't Sweat I.T: **Tips to Tackle Common Tech Problems**

New technology appears at such a rapid rate that sometimes it is hard to keep up. Whether it is a new invention, the latest version of a popular product or a revolutionary way a tool is being used; in this gadget-centric and technology-driven world, it is easy to get overwhelmed. It can also be hard to keep up with *how* technology is being used and there are many times when we can get stumped because it is 'too hard' or it simply can't be solved. Or can it?

Let's look at some of the common tech problems one may face and how to tackle them :

HELP! Why do I keep receiing SPAM mails?

Yes, as frustrating and annoying as it is, once you own a public email address, no one can stop SPAM mails from coming in. A suggestion is, you may want to consider having more than one e-mail address: use one address whenever you sign up for anything on the Web, and give your other address only to people you know. Also, when you do get spam mail, never reply or click a link offering to remove you from their mailing list. This will only confirm your address is real and you will then get even more spam. Never sign up for any spam e-mail opt-out lists, these are just another attempt to get your email address or money. More importantly, do check that you have up-to-date anti-virus software. If a virus infects your PC it may try to use your address book to spread itself through e-mail spam to all your contacts.

HELP! My PC is too slow!

If you don't know where to begin fixing the slow computer, the good idea is to begin with inspecting the hard disk drive for it is the most common cause of poor PC performance. Check for disk errors, bad sectors, low disk space issues and fragmentation level. You can do this with any good freely available disk diagnostic tool you may find on internet. Once you are done with diagnosing and troubleshooting your hard disk, run a scan for operating system issues. These include registry scan, antivirus scan and system files scan. Check if there are any issues with it. This is how PC repair experts repair their home computers.

HELP! I need to shop online, is this website safe?

While online shopping can be addictive, extra precaution should also be made to ensure that your credit card information is safe from fraudulent websites. To know whether a site is secure before you give your credit card details, look at the address bar and make sure the web address begins with https://. There should also be a padlock symbol on the address bar to indicate the site is secure.
