THE PERSPECTIVE

TEACH VS EDUCATE

We have always been familiar with the terms teachers and teach. These days, terms like educators and educate are widely used as well. In fact, we have come across the interchangeable use of teaching and education in many contexts. Nevertheless, these two terms; "teach" and "educate" are not perfect synonyms and definitely not antonyms. Each has its own meaning which sparks a never ending debate in the learning environment where one may be often asked "Do you teach or do you educate?".



The Challenge

As a teacher, the daily routines are usually taking attendance, planning out your lessons and giving quizzes to ensure the students have learnt the new words or formulas being taught to them. However, despite the tight schedule of every teacher, it is implicitly and/or explicitly required of a teacher to show the students the way to gather knowledge and not to simply impart the knowledge to the students. It is becoming important for a teacher to impart lifelong knowledge to the students so as to equip them with a solid foundation to be able to do well independently in the working society.

Teaching is not about memorizing the multiplication table but rather than to enable the students, as an individual to learn and acquire knowledge of Math - involving the process of educating.

As you prepare your next lesson plan, be a teacher and an educator. You lead by example.

On the topic of "going green", you can teach the students that to be green is a daily lifestyle. You may start posting lessons online to save paper; promote the use of recycling bins for used bottles; cans and paper; and encourage the use of an awesome reusable mug for your drinks. It is not sufficient to "tell" the students that they need to be environmentally green.

In this present time, where the boundaries of learning have been removed from just the four corners of the classroom, students become more socially interconnected. It is the era of today whereby students are getting ready and/or are already experiencing the 21st Century learning.

Many teachers are incorporating new technologies into their classrooms and using internet's creative resources as tools to build learning foundations. They have utilised more interactive learning to teach students to interact with students and teachers beyond the classrooms.



Teachers are now using both traditional learning and online learning to create a blended learning approach to become Educators of today's world.

We trust that, teaching to educate means that students are being taught valuable lessons that are meant to last. Teaching to test means that students are being stuffed full of information just to take a test, not to retain it for a lifetime.

What is teach & educate?

To teach or teaching would mean to use a specific methodology of practice to share information or pass information to another person. To teach is to conduct an activity to guide someone to learn something.

- Teaching is an approach, step or an act to guide
- Teaching involves showing by reason, a proof or making clear by use of example

To educate or educating would mean not just relaying the information to another person but getting them to understand and accept the information relayed.

- Educating is an approach to enlighten the person and lead his/her understanding
- Educating broadly involves teaching which may have a formative effect on the way a person thinks, feels or acts

5. Fairness

6. Flexibility

One of the tenets of teaching should be that everything is in a constant state of change. Interruptions and disruptions are the norm and very few days are 'typical'. A flexible attitude is important for your students who expect you to be in charge and take control of any situation.


I foresee myself taking up more challenges in the future. I am confident that both myselfand the company will grow and advance higher with all the clients and schools appreciating the choice of ACP.

Media Literacy Program in St. Hilda's Primary Shool
